Christian Initiation RITES

<u>The Rite of Acceptance</u>—a ritual in which an unbaptized person expresses his/her intention to be baptized. The non-baptized becomes a catechumen.

The Rite of Welcoming—a ritual in which a baptized person expresses his/her intention to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church. The baptized Christian becomes a candidate.

These are usually offered the first of the new year as needed.

The Rite of Election/Continuing Conversion—This rite is a passage in which the catechumen's godparent or the candidates sponsor testifies on behalf of the catechumen or candidate that his/her heart and mind have been transformed by Jesus Christ. The non-baptized is not referred to as an elect, while a baptized person is still called a candidate. The Rite of Election is always held the Sunday after Ash Wednesday

This year it will be on **Sunday March 1st at the 10:00 Mass at the Cathedral.**
